The said two ICERT MESO Rural Hospitals are 50-Bedded Rural First-Referral-Unit (F.R.U.) Hospitals offering services in line with the framework of Community Health Centres of the Department of Health, Family Welfare & Medical Education. The catchment area of the said two Hospitals is Kuchai Block of Seraikela-

Kharsawan and Basaardih-Hesal area of Lohardaga Block of Lohardaga District. ICERT has also initiated the operations, running and management of 07 state-of-the-art Mobile Medical Units (fully furnished mobile poly-clinics) in PPP Mode with the Jharkhand Rural Health Mission Society (NRHM), Department of Health, Family Welfare & Medical Education. ICERT has also entered into formal tie-ups with hospital groups and other reputed NGOs / like-minded Organization(s) working in remote rural areas and agricultural zones keeping in view its future projects and focus areas.
